

audio PIN that will allow us to unmute your line if you wish to ask a question during the webinar.

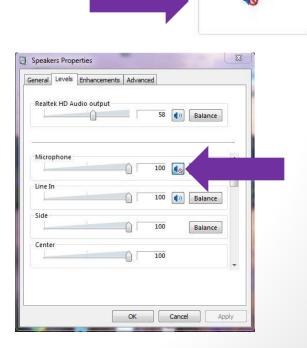
When using the **telephone**, please mute both the speakers and microphone on your computer, as they may cause an echo.

Click on the speaker icon on the bottom right of your screen and click on the speaker to mute or slide the bar down.


Click on Speakers, then click on the icon next to microphone to mute.
